THE ORATORY SUMMER SCHOOL

Since 1989, the Oratory has offered a summer school for lay people. There are two week-long sessions, with three classes each day, taught by one of the Fathers or Brothers of the Oratory. A special Mass is celebrated. And lunch is served. The day begins at 8:30 a.m. and ends at 3:00 p.m. The Oratory can accommodate a limited number of people in the seminary residence. The fee for the course is \$175 per session, which includes lunch. The surcharge for rooms in the seminary residence is \$75 per week. Please note that the courses are aimed at adults and older teens.

Session 1: July 2-6, 2018 – The first week is an introduction to the Catechism of the Catholic Church. This session is a prerequisite for enrolment in the second session, taken either in the current year or in previous years.
