

Soul of Christ, be my sanctification; Body of Christ, be my salvation; Blood of Christ, fill my veins; Water of Christ's side, wash out my stains; Passion of Christ, my comfort be; O good Jesus, listen to me; In Thy wounds I fain would hide; Never to be parted from Thy side; Guard me, should the foe assail me: Call me when my life shall fail me; Bid me come to Thee above, With Thy saints to sing Thy love, World without end. Amen.

THE ORATORY SUMMER SCHOOL

SOLEMNITY OF THE SACRED HEART OF JESUS

The Feast of the Most Sacred Heart is a solemnity in the liturgical calendar of the Roman Catholic Church. It falls 19 days after Pentecost, and therefore on *a Friday*, but since it is a Solemnity it is not a day of abstinence. On June 5, 2005, Emeritus Pope Benedict XVI said: "In biblical language, "heart" indicates the centre of the person where his sentiments and intentions dwell. In the Heart of the Redeemer we adore God's love for humanity, his will for universal salvation, his infinite mercy. Practising devotion to the Sacred Heart of Christ therefore means adoring that Heart which, after having loved us to the end, was pierced by a spear and from high on the Cross poured out blood and water, an inexhaustible source of new life".
