

Second Session: July 9-13 THE CHURCH IN THE APOSTOLIC AGE

Many non-Catholics reject most of the distinctly Catholic practices and beliefs as human traditions, not founded on Scripture. The Church's understanding of the sacraments and the nature of the Church itself are often seen as mere imports from pagan culture. They present the reformation as a return to a truly Bible-based Christianity. But even an introductory study of the time of the Apostles and their immediate successors (the Apostolic Fathers) shows that this view does not stand the test of history. What the Church believed then, at the time of the apostles themselves, was decidedly Catholic, recognizably what we still believe and always have believed. Studying these first generations of Catholics is both a great blessing and provides answers to many questions about our faith. **Participants should have completed the First Session** (Introductory Survey), either this year or in a previous year.

REGISTERED IN THE PARISH?
