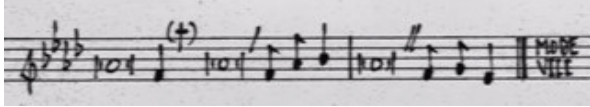

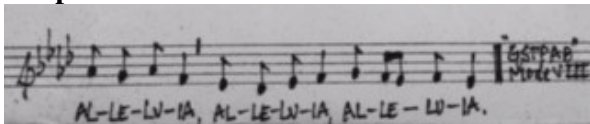

**SCAM ALERT –  
PRIEST REQUEST FOR GIFT CARD**

An email scam targeting parishioners in Catholic churches across Canada is now active in the Archdiocese of Toronto.

The scam, previously reported by several other dioceses, has now appeared in our own diocese with reports of at least one parishioner who lost \$300 to a fraudster pretending to be the pastor of a parish. Several other dioceses had reported an email scam in which Catholics have received requests, purportedly from their parish priests, for iTunes gift cards. A false email from a priest is sent asking for the electronic gift cards to be sent to another address so that they may be given to someone in need.

Please be assured that your pastor will NEVER send you an e-mail asking for gift cards. In general, always exercise caution when checking email messages. Think before you click or open attachments, and always verify suspect messages by phoning the sender on a known phone number (not the phone number in the suspect message).

**MISSION APPEAL**

Next weekend Fr. Ramesh Christy will make a Mission Appeal on behalf of the Diocese of Batticaloa in Sri Lanka. The Batticaloa Diocese still has not yet recovered from the civil war (1983-2009) and the tsunami (2004). Many people are displaced from their homes and many are homeless. There are orphaned children. Our appeal is to have a place for handicapped children who will be cared by the Missionaries and educating the children with evening classes in several areas of the Diocese.
