

BL. JOHN HENRY CARDINAL NEWMAN

John Henry Newman (1801-1890) was an Anglican clergyman and a teacher at Oxford University. In 1845, at the age of 44, he became a Roman Catholic and soon after was ordained a priest. He established the English Oratory of St. Philip Neri. He was ordained a cardinal by Pope Leo XIII, in 1879. In Birmingham, England on September 19, 2010 he was beatified by Pope Benedict XVI, giving him the title Blessed John Henry Cardinal Newman.
