

Archdiocesan Assessment: Every six months we make a financial report to the Archdiocese of Toronto, following which we receive a bill called the Archdiocesan Assessment (also known as the Cathedraticum). This Assessment is based on the parish income, with certain categories of expenses (e.g. special projects) being exempt from the tax.

The Archdiocese has notified parishes that over the years, more income has been exempted from the tax than the policy originally envisaged. For example, our Maintenance and Debt Fund collections have been exempt, even though the policy envisaged exemptions only for special projects. That loophole is being closed. From now on, the only exemptions will be for approved projects, funds for which have been spent on the project or deposited with the Archdiocese. We will be putting aside some money for the kitchen project to be exempted from the tax, but we need to be aware that our bill from the Archdiocese in the spring will be higher than in previous years.

At St Vincent's, we have long been taxed at a lower rate than most parishes. We pray that will continue.
