BILL C6 (WAS BILL C8)
The bill is ostensibly about prohibiting "conversion therapy", which should be prohibited if it means coercive actions against people's wills or degrading "therapies". But the language of the bill is dangerous, for, as it stands it could be used to prosecute parents or priests who counsel chastity and speak about God's gift of sexuality as the Church understands it, or to shut down groups such as Courage, which help people with same sex attraction to live authentic Christian lives. The proponents of the bill in their various propaganda say that C6 is not aimed against parents, priests, and other counselors, but it is the language of the bill as passed and not the smooth talk around it that will be the basis of its application. Parents, priests and counselors need protection in proclaiming the truth about sexuality.
