2021 SACRAMENTS

First Confession and First Holy Communion classes are for children in Grade 2 or older.

Confirmation is conferred in the Archdiocese of Toronto in Grade 7 (or later), for those who have not been confirmed).

At the moment, the Covid restrictions prevent us from beginning live classes. We will see whether it looks like those restrictions will be lifted. If not, we will plan another way to help your children prepare for these Sacraments.

ADVENT

We begin the Holy Season of Advent in a situation when once more we are unable to take part in holy Mass except 'virtually'. Part of the meaning of Advent is watchful expectation, both for the first coming of the Lord and for His Second Coming. Perhaps we can see the deprivation of the Eucharist in that light: an opportunity to deepen our longing for the Lord. At least we can still visit the Blessed Sacrament at this time. And we can deepen our prayer life with our families at home and in church, and watch Mass online.

We can remember also that we are not being singled out for this hardship. Many people have suffered and are suffering great hardships in making their living: restaurant owners and workers, owners and operators of gyms, indeed all the businesses that are restricted or closed. Many have suffered and are suffering psychologically. Many have health problems that are not being addressed. A few are even suffering from Covid. Health care workers have been overloaded. The aged in long-term care homes are not being visited. Let us remember all of these people in our prayers.
