SIXTH SUNDAY OF ORDINARY TIME

Among the things to note: the church is open for prayer, for a maximum of ten persons at a time. Communion services are offered on Saturday afternoon and Sunday (see below). Public Masses have been suspended. Here is the schedule of opening hours for the church: Monday to Friday 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Saturday 10:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. and Sunday 8:30 a.m. to 10:30 a.m. and 1:45 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. On Sunday, the church will be closed from 10:30 a.m. to 1:45 p.m. for livestreaming of Mass within the church.

The Fathers of the Oratory are livestreaming two Masses daily from one of our chapels, one in English and one in Latin. The 11 a.m. Sunday Mass in English is livestreamed from this church.

Here at St Vincent's, we will have **Confessions** Friday from 11:00 a.m. to noon and Saturday 4:00 to 5:00 p.m.

The parish office is open with reduced hours to the public.

We are required under the city of Toronto by-law to wear masks in church, unless we are exempted.

Sanitizing materials are available in the church for you to sanitize the place where you are praying. We recommend that you sanitize both upon your arrival and your departure.

HOLY COMMUNION SERVICES

Once again (unless new restrictions are imposed upon us), we will be offering Holy Communion on Saturday afternoon and Sunday (morning and afternoon) for nine persons at a time, because of the limitation that only ten persons are permitted in the church at a time. Reservations are required through the SignUpGenius link that will be sent to those on the parish email list and posted on the Toronto Oratory website.

ASH WEDNESDAY

LENT BEGINS FEBRUARY 17

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of fast and abstinence.

Cardinal Collins has given permission to parishes to have services of the giving of ashes and Holy Communion on Ash Wednesday, *and also* on Thursday, on Friday, and on Saturday morning of this week.

We will have these services every fifteen minutes during the following hours:

Ash Wednesday: 8 – 11 a.m. 2 – 5 p.m. 8 – 9 p.m.

Thursday, Feb. 18: 8 – 11 a.m. 8 – 9 p.m.

Friday, Feb. 19: 8 – 11 a.m. 8 – 9 p.m.

Saturday, Feb. 20: 9 a.m. – 12 noon.

Please check the link on the Oratory website (previous page of this bulletin) for details and to sign up. If you have been receiving SignUp notices for Communion services, you will receive this one also.

Following a protocol given by the Holy See, ashes will be distributed by having them sprinkled upon your head rather than our customary method of making a sign of the cross on your forehead with them. This method of distribution of ashes is very ancient, and I have seen many photographs of Popes on Ash Wednesday receiving their ashes in this way. The priest or deacon will pronounce the formula once, and then come to sprinkle the ashes on the top of your head. Then he will distribute Holy Communion.

More details on what we will do for Lent will be forthcoming.

You will be emailed account information which you can use to set up the Archdiocese of Toronto as a Payee in your online banking. Your gift will be forwarded to our parish. You can make a one time or recurring gift to our offertory. *This method of giving to the parish puts you in charge. You do not need to get in touch with us to alter amounts, frequency, or even to cancel. If you use web banking this is the best option for you.*
