At present we have short Holy Communion services for up to 10 people at a time (including the priest) on Saturdays and Sundays. These are scheduled in consecutive 15-minute segments. You can sign up for a timeslot at this link each week.

If you know parishioners who are not tech savvy, please feel free to sign them up, or ask them to call the Oratory (416 532-2879) between 9 a.m. and 5 p.m. so that we can sign them up. Please sign up only once each weekend to allow as many parishioners as possible the opportunity to receive Communion. Please note that you can deregister yourself in case you are feeling sick or need to change your plans. You do not need to phone us to do it. The schedule for Communion services will be as follows:

Saturday: 3:00-4:00pm; 5:00-6:00pm

Sunday: 8:00-10:30am; 2:00pm-4:00pm

The schedule of regular livestreamed Masses is as follows: Sunday 11 a.m. from St Vincent's; Sunday 11 a.m. from Holy Family, Solemn High Mass (Usus Antiquior); Monday to Friday, 7:45 a.m. (English), 11:30 a.m. (Latin). Saturday 10 a.m. (English), 11:30 a.m. (Latin).

Friday 11 a.m. – 12 noon; Saturday 4 – 5 p.m.

At Holy Family:

Monday through Friday 7:30 - 8:00 a.m. and 5 – 6 p.m.

Also Wednesday and Thursday 8 - 9 p.m.; Saturday 4 – 5 p.m., Sunday 4:30 – 5 p.m.

**We are required under the city of Toronto by-law to wear masks in church, unless you are exempted.**

**Sanitizing materials are available in the church for you to sanitize the place where you are praying. If a pew is not going to be used again within an hour it does not need to be sanitized. Sanitizing, therefore, will not be needed Monday to Saturday, but will be needed on Sunday, we ask one person to sanitize the altar rail after each Communion Service.**

### FEAST OF CORPUS CHRISTI

The Anima Christi is a prayer from around the 14th century. It is still widely used after receiving the body and blood of Our Lord, Jesus Christ in Holy Communion. This prayer is the translation of Blessed John Henry Cardinal Newman.

#### ANIMA CHRISTI

*Soul of Christ, be my sanctification;  
Body of Christ, be my salvation;  
Blood of Christ, fill my veins;  
Water of Christ's side, wash out my stains;  
Passion of Christ, my comfort be;  
O good Jesus, listen to me;  
In Thy wounds I fain would hide;  
Never to be parted from Thy side;  
Guard me, should the foe assail me;  
Call me when my life shall fail me;  
Bid me come to Thee above,  
With Thy saints to sing Thy love,  
World without end. Amen.*

### SOLEMNITY OF THE SACRED HEART OF JESUS

The Feast of the Most Sacred Heart is a solemnity in the liturgical calendar of the Roman Catholic Church. It falls 19 days after Pentecost, and therefore on **a Friday, but since it is a Solemnity it is not a day of abstinence.**

You can make a one time or recurring gift to our offertory. ***This method of giving to the parish puts you in charge.
