



OUR LADY OF LOURDES

On February 11, 1858, Our Lady appeared to a 14 year old girl named Bernadette Soubirous. The oldest of six children of a poor family, Bernadette was often sick.

That day she went with her sister and a friend to collect wood. When they saw lots of wood across the river, the two girls ran across the river. While Bernadette was taking her shoes off in order to cross the river, she heard a rustling noise and looked up to the cave where she saw a beautiful lady in a lovely white dress holding a rosary. This was the first of 18 appearances of Our Lady to Bernadette. Mary asked Bernadette to pray the rosary, do penance, and pray for sinners.

On February 25, 1858, Our Lady told Bernadette to drink the water. She pointed to a trickle of water nearby. Bernadette could only get a few drops; there was more mud than water. Bernadette started scraping the ground until she found enough water to drink. People saw this and laughed at Bernadette. Soon miracles started to happen with this water. A spring developed. People would wash themselves with the water and take home bottles filled with the water. To this day the spring continues to produce water.
