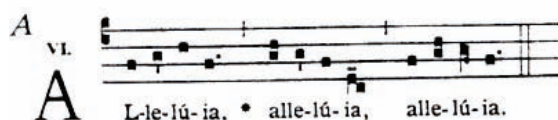

### DOUBLE YOUR GIFT!

A parishioner recently approached me with a generous anonymous offer. As you know, we have a big project in the works: repairing the roof of the apse, the half-dome over the sanctuary. The project, depending on the condition of the roof, could cost up to nearly \$200,000. The donor will match any donations toward the repair of the roof up to a total of **\$70,000**. If someone donates \$20,000, it will be matched, giving us \$40,000 toward the project. Your gift of \$10,000 will become \$20,000; your gift of a \$1,000 will become \$2,000. If forty parishioners give \$500 each, their \$20,000 total will yield \$20,000 more. Whatever you give, whether \$200, \$100, \$75, \$50 or \$20 -- your gift will be doubled! In fact, it will be more than doubled: every \$10,000 donated will mean that our loan can be smaller by \$20,000. At 2.5% interest, that would mean a further saving to the parish of \$500 per year.

I hope many of you will be inspired by this parishioner's generosity to be as generous as you can be. Please indicate that your donation is for the roof project. Please pray for the intentions of the donor.

**July 4 – 8: *The Catechism of the Catholic***

**July 11 – 15: *Books (and People) that Begin with S***

This year we celebrate the 400th anniversary of the canonization of the “Five Saints” —Saints Philip Neri, Ignatius of Loyola, Francis Xavier, Teresa of Avila, and Isidore the Farmer. It was an important celebration of the spiritual fruitfulness of the Catholic Counter-Reformation. The anniversary gives us the opportunity to reflect on the idea of sanctity and the powerful example that the saints give us, the Church’s beginning to recognize various Christians as saints in the liturgy, and the canonical process of canonization the Church developed. Saint Philip was convinced that Catholics should give more attention to lives of the saints—reading books that begin with the letter “S”, like Saint Augustine, Saint Benedict, etc.

Lectures will be at 8:30 a.m., 11:00 a.m., and 1:15 p.m., with Mass at 10:00 a.m. Lunch is provided for those attending in person. **The course will be available in person and online.** For online, the cost for each session will be \$150. For those attending in person, the cost for each session will be \$175 per person, which includes lunch for the five days.
