HOLY WATER

A Prayer to say when using holy water

By this holy water and by Your Precious Blood, wash away all my sins, O Lord.

Holy water is a sacramental whose use represents a cleansing of the soul. It is an act of faith and devotion to make the sign of the Cross with holy water, as upon entering a church. Holy water is a constant reminder of our Baptism, and its devout use remits venial sins. It is also beneficial when used against the assaults of spiritual enemies.

DEDICATION OF THE BASILICA OF SAINT MARY MAJOR

The construction of the basilica started in 358 by Pope Liberius. It was consecrated under the title of the Virgin Mary by Pope Sixtus III in 435, after the Council of Ephesus in 431 at which Mary was declared to be the Mother of God. It is also called Maria ad Nives, Mary of the Snows. It is said that Mary chose the site of the church by a snowfall on the spot in summer. At the same time, she appeared to a wealthy nobleman named John and Pope Liberius, asking them to build a church. The basilica is also known as “church of the crib” because the relic of the holy crib/manger in which Jesus was laid at His birth, is kept inside of a silver manger replica in a glass case. On Christmas day the holy manger is taken out of the case and exposed to the faithful.
