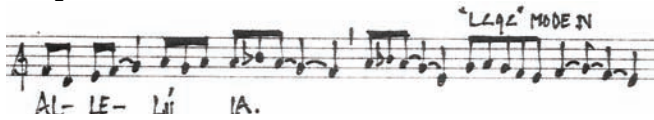

**Day 4:** To Petra; visit treasury, monastery & amphitheatre. On to Amman

**Day 5:** Travel to Madaba, famous for Byzantine & Umayyad mosaics. Stop at Mt. Nebo, where Moses saw the Promised Land. Cross Jordan, move to Galilee

**Day 6:** To Tiberias: travel by boat on Sea of Galilee; visit Capernaum; on to Tabgha; Church of the Multiplication; Church of the Primacy; Mass on Mt. of Beatitudes

**Day 7:** Cana: celebrate marriage renewal ceremony; Nazareth; Mass at Annunciation Basilica; ascend Mt. Tabor (Transfiguration)

**Day 8:** Depart Galilee for Jordan; visit Haifa & Mt. Carmel

**Day 9:** Ancient Jerusalem: Pool of Bethesda, Pilate's Judgement Hall, Chapel of Flagellation, Via Dolorosa, Holy Sepulchre

**Day 10:** Bethlehem: Mass in grotto; Crusaders' Cloister, St. Jerome's Grotto, Shepherds' Field; Mt. Zion & Upper Room

**Day 11:** Masada, swim in Dead Sea & Jericho

**Day 12:** Breakfast; return to Tel Aviv; flight to Toronto. Afternoon arrival

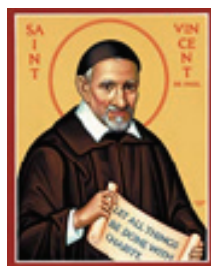

### FEAST OF ST VINCENT DE PAUL



*He was born on April 24, 1581 in the southwest of France to a poor family. He was an intelligent youth, studying theology at age 15. His ordination to the priesthood was in 1600 and he worked as a tutor to students in Toulouse.*

*During a sea voyage in 1605, Vincent was seized by Turkish pirates and sold into slavery. His captivity lasted until 1607, during which he converted his owner to Christianity and both escaped from Tunisia.*

*Although Vincent had initially begun his priesthood with the intention of securing a life of leisure for himself, he underwent a change of heart after hearing the confession of a dying peasant. Moved with compassion for the poor, he began undertaking missions and founding institutions to help them both materially and spiritually.*

*In 1625, he established the Congregation of Priests of the Mission. Not long after this, he worked with the future Saint Louise de Marillac to organize the Daughters of Charity, the first congregation of women religious whose consecrated life involved an extensive apostolate among the poor, the sick, and prisoners. The order collected donations, which Vincent distributed widely among the needy.*

*He was admired for all his accomplishments during his lifetime, but he maintained humility, using his reputation and connections to help the poor.*

*St Vincent de Paul died on September 27, 1660. Pope Clement XII canonized him in 1737. In 1835, the French scholar Blessed Frederic Ozanam took him as the inspiration and namesake for the Society of Saint Vincent de Paul, a lay Catholic organization working for the relief of the poor.*
