Dear Parishioners,

If you have been around the east side of the church, perhaps you have seen the new copper half-dome, which is now completed. There is still some tuckpointing to be done on the east wall, but the biggest part of the project is done. So far, we have raised about \$63,000 for the project, \$30,000 of which has come from our matching donor. Donations are still welcome and will be doubled by that donor. The success of the fund-raising, and the fact that the project came in for a lower price than our estimate, means that our loan will not be as large as we had anticipated. There is an immediate need for families to host for a period of between one to six months some of those who have arrived.
