

ST. BLAISE

On **Friday, February 3**, feast of St. Blaise, there will be the blessing of the throats after the Mass.

St. Blaise was a native of Sebaste in Armenia and became bishop of his native city. He had to go into hiding to escape continual persecution, but was finally arrested, atrociously tortured and put to death, under Licinius in 316. His cult spread rapidly in both East and West and many cures were attributed to him, notably that of a child who was suffocating through a bone being caught in his throat. He is invoked for all throat afflictions and on his feast, two candles are blessed with a prayer that God will free from all such afflictions and every ill all those who receive the blessing in the Ritual, with these candles applied to their throat. St. Blaise is one of the Fourteen Holy Helpers.

BLESSED SEBASTIAN VALFRE



"When it is all over you will not regret having suffered; rather you will regret having suffered so little, and suffered that little so badly."

Bl Sebastian was born on March 9, 1629 to a humble and poor family.

He remained poor throughout his life in the Congregation at Turin. At the Oratory he wished simply to serve the people of God in whatever capacity he was given, whether in pastoral work, house administration, scholarly pursuits, or sweeping the stairs. He would as happily go to the death beds of the poor or the Royal family of Savoy. Most of his life was spent wandering around the streets and squares simply being available, speaking of God's love for all men and of the love that we should have for each other. The Apostle of Turin died on January 30, 1710. He was beatified by Pope Gregory XVI in 1834.
