ASCENSION DAY

Forty days after the Resurrection, our Blessed Lord ascended into heaven. From there He will come again in glory to judge the living and the dead. In the meantime, it is the task of His disciples, strengthened by the Holy Spirit, to spread the Gospel throughout the world. Let us ask the Holy Spirit to kindle in us the fire of divine love. Traditionally, and still in some countries, the feast of the Ascension is celebrated forty days after Easter, on a Thursday, which this year falls on May 18. In Canada, for the Ordinary Form of the Mass, the Solemnity is transferred to the next Sunday. For those who celebrate the Extraordinary Form of the Mass, the liturgy of the Ascension is still celebrated on the Thursday. **There will be a Solemn High Mass at Holy Family on Thursday, May 18 at 8:00 p.m.**
