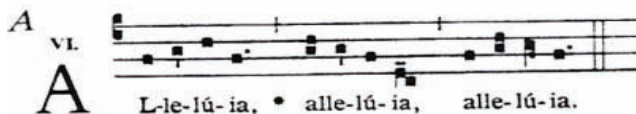

ORATORY SUMMER SCHOOL

July 3 – 7: *Catechism of the Catholic Church*

July 10 – 14: *The Life, writings and Legacy of Joseph Ratzinger (Benedict XVI)*

Joseph Ratzinger was a major participant in the renewal of theology that preceded the Second Vatican Council, was profoundly involved in the Council itself as a theological adviser, and was subsequently increasingly influential in the very heart of the ecclesiastical hierarchy. Ratzinger's life and thought are therefore indispensable as contributions to the authentic interpretation of Catholic faith and practice in the present time. Accordingly, we hope that the second week of Summer School this year will be an occasion for a renewed examination of the strengths and weaknesses, the fruits and the controversies, of this immensely consequential period in the history of the Church.

MARY, MOTHER OF THE CHURCH

In 2018, Pope Francis decreed that the Monday after Pentecost be celebrated as the memorial of Mary, Mother of Church.

The decree establishing the memorial was published March 3, 2018 in a letter from Cardinal Robert Sarah, head of the Congregation for Divine Worship and the Discipline of the Sacraments.

As Cardinal Sarah explained, Pope Francis added the memorial to the Roman Calendar after carefully considering how the promotion of devotion to the Blessed Virgin Mary under this particular title might encourage growth in “the maternal sense of the Church” and in “genuine Marian piety.”

**VISITATION OF THE
BLESSED VIRGIN MARY**

After Second Vatican Council, the date for the feast was changed to May 31, the month dedicated to Mary. God wants to use you, as He did Mary, to become the instrument by which His grace is sent to the hearts of those to whom God is sending you.

Most glorious Virgin Mary, you were filled with the Holy Spirit at the time of the Annunciation and carried the Eternal Son of the Father within you. As you journeyed to visit Elizabeth, you did so with holy urgency and drive, enabling you to fulfil the will of Your Son. Please pray for me, that I may be filled with that same urgency to become holy and to spread that holiness to others. Mother Mary, pray for me. Jesus, I trust in You.
