#### ST JOHN VIANNEY, PRAY FOR US!

He was a priest in the village of Ars, near Lyons. He brought Christ to his parishioners through the celebration of the Eucharist, assisting the poor, and most especially by the Sacrament of Penance. Reports of his holiness and the gift of seeing souls soon spread. He spent eleven to sixteen hours a day hearing confessions of pilgrims. He died on August 4, 1859.

# DEDICATION OF THE BASILICA OF SAINT MARY MAJOR

The construction of the basilica started in 358 by Pope Liberius. It was consecrated under the title of the Virgin Mary by Pope Sixtus III in 435, after the Council of Ephesus in 431 at which Mary was declared to be the Mother of God. It is also called Maria ad Nives, Mary of the Snows. It is said that Mary chose the site of the church by a snowfall on the spot in summer. At the same time, she appeared to a wealthy nobleman named John and to Pope Liberius, asking them to build a church. The basilica is also known as "church of the crib" because the relic of the holy crib/manger in which Jesus was laid at His birth is kept inside of a silver manger replica in a glass case. On Christmas day the holy manger is taken out of the case and exposed to the faithful.
