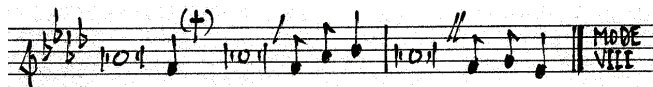

ADELPHI CONCERT IS BACK!

Friday, September 8 at 8:00 pm

There will be an organ and choral at St. Vincent de Paul Church. The ADELPHI Vocal Ensemble, directed by Peter Bishop, will present a musical programme in honour of the birth of the Blessed Virgin Mary, which the Church celebrates on this day. We have not been able to have an Adelphi concert since February 2020 (for various reasons), so this is a special event for us! Among the music to be heard will be: parts of the Messe Basse, a setting of parts of the Mass by Gabriel Fauré; the Cantique de Jeane Racine (“Word of God, Word made Flesh”) also by Fauré; the popular Ubi caritas (“Where charity and love abide”) by Maurice Duruflé; and the motet, O magnum mysterium by the American composer Morten Lauridsen.

Organist Aaron James, Director of Music of the Oratory will accompany the choir and play solo organ music. Admission is free, but a \$25 donation is suggested and encouraged.

BL. JUVENAL ANCINA

Blessed Juvenal is the only one of our Oratorian Blesseds to have known St Philip personally. A physician, he was moved to a deeper practice of his Faith one day when hearing the *Dies Irae* at a funeral. He and his brother Giovanni Matteo went to Rome seeking a vocation and thought of joining the Carthusians. On a second trip to Rome Juvenal discovered the Oratory, and St Philip persuaded him to join, where he became one of the most popular preachers, and also composed music which was used at the Oratory exercises. In 1586 he was sent to the new Oratory at Naples, where his fame as a good preacher and holy priest continued to grow. When there was talk that he would be made a bishop he went into hiding for several months, but after St Philip’s death he was unable to avoid the desires of the Holy Father and in 1602 was made Bishop of Saluzzo in Piedmont. St Francis de Sales was a close friend and gave testimony at the Process for Juvenal’s beatification.

In 1604 Juvenal was poisoned by a friar whom he had rebuked for scandalous living, but refused to testify against him.

Juvenal’s body rests in Saluzzo Cathedral, under an altar dedicated to him. He was beatified by Pope Leo XIII on 9th February, 1890, and his feast is kept each year on 30th August.
