



100TH ANNIVERSARY CORNER



Do you know your church?

As we walk down the centre aisle and gaze at the ceiling in the nave, after the Lamb of God standing on the book, we see a third medallion depicting loaves and fish. Our Lord miraculously multiplied the fives loaves and two fish to feed five thousand. This miracle is the only miracle recounted by all four Gospels. What is the connection between the feeding of the five thousand and the Holy Eucharist? 1) As Jesus miraculously transformed bread and fish, so he can miraculously transform bread and wine at the Last Supper. 2) As all ate and were satisfied that day in the wilderness, so those who receive the Eucharist can be spiritually satisfied "with every grace and heavenly blessing." 3) As those who eat the bread and fish received nourishment to make the long journey to their homes, so we who eat the Eucharist receive spiritual nourishment to make the long and difficult journey to our heavenly home. 4) All of the above.

Last week's Answer: All of the above. Our Lord is not only our spiritual food, he is also our sacrificial victim. He is the true Lamb of God foreshadowed by the Jewish Passover Lamb. He is the Lamb once slain who lives forever in heaven as our priest. Christ is both our priest and our sacrifice. By the words of the Mass, in the double consecration, Christ's sacrifice is symbolized and made present.

Trivia – St Vincent de Paul's Life and Times:

Why did St Vincent go from helping the poor to also training priests? As he encountered the material poverty of France, he discovered a deeper poverty, a poverty of spiritual riches. As he preached missions in the rural districts, he discovered widespread ignorance and lack of faith. He wanted to help relieve this spiritual poverty. But after his effective missions, how could he ensure the people would continue to be fed with the Gospel of Jesus Christ? He needed priests. The sheep needed good shepherds. Please pray for the priests and seminarians at St Philip's seminary in this new academic year. The kind of work St Vincent did still goes on at St Philip's seminary.
