Last week's Answer: All of the above. Christ becomes our food for the soul as He is now in heaven. We receive the risen and glorified Christ. The same Christ is our great High Priest who lives in heaven to make intercession for us at the heavenly liturgy. At the moment of the Ascension of Christ's body into heaven, the sacramental economy, the whole liturgical life of the Church was inaugurated. Christ makes present in the Mass his own Ascension so that our minds might be lifted up.

Trivia – St Vincent de Paul's Life and Times:

When St Vincent founded his own order of priests, they were called the Congregation of the Missions (CM). Vincent wrote a special set of common rules. That document was never translated into English or made public until 1993. It can now be found in the *Classics of Western Spirituality* series.

Wisdom from St Vincent de Paul:

“Christ's teaching will never let us down, while worldly wisdom always will.” (Common Rules, ch 2).
