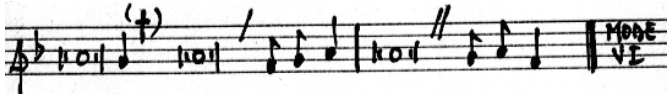

BL. SALVIO HUIX MIRALPEIX, PRAY FOR US

Blessed Salvio was born on December 22, 1877 in Santa Margarida de Vellors in the Diocese of Vic in Catalonia, Spain. He was born into a pious and wealthy family. Salvio was known for his hard work as a student and seminarian and for his problems controlling his temper. He was ordained a priest in 1903 and four years later he entered the Congregation of the Oratory of Vic. For twenty years he lived the Oratorian life of prayer, preaching and administering the Sacraments. In 1927, he became the Provost of the Vic Oratory, and then was nominated as Bishop of Ibiza. He was imprisoned during the Spanish Civil War in 1936. With his fellow prisoners he shared suffering and the joys of secret prayers and Masses. He died a martyr's death when he was shot by Republican forces on the morning of August 5, 1936. The beatification of Bishop Salvio HuiX Miralpeix, the first Oratorian martyr, took place in Tarragona, Spain, on October 13, 2013.

Almighty and eternal God, who in your goodness bestowed on the bishop and martyr Salvio HuiX the gift of pastoral charity even to the point of shedding of his blood for Christ and his Church, bestow on us also the grace to work faithfully in your vineyard and to experience his intercession in this life. Through Christ our Lord. Amen.

Last week's Answer: Five Wounds of Christ. After he rose from the dead, Christ kept the marks of the nails in his hands and feet as well as the large wound in his side. These wounds no longer hurt. His wounds were glorified and used for a purpose. They helped his disciples to believe and to recognize Him. "See my hands and my feet," he told them and added "It is I."

Trivia – St Vincent de Paul's Life and Times:

In 1852 Bl Frederick Ozanam, the founder of the Society of St Vincent de Paul, made a pilgrimage to the birthplace of St Vincent de Paul in Pouy. He wrote a letter about what he saw:

"There we saw the old oak tree under which St Vincent de Paul, the boy shepherd, took shelter while herding his flock. That fine old tree is now held to the soil only by the bark, which is eaten with age. But the branches are superb and even at the advanced season when we were there, the foliage was beautifully green. I saw it as a type of the foundations of St Vincent de Paul which have no apparent bond of union with earth, but which nevertheless triumph over time and grow strong during revolution."

Two hundred years after he died, St Vincent de Paul continued to inspire saintly disciples. 170 years later, the work of St Vincent is not finished. May his spirit enter our hearts. May we learn to love what he loved.

Wisdom from St Vincent de Paul:

"God's works are not regulated by our plans and wishes. We should be content with making the best of the few talents he has placed in our hands, and not distress ourselves about having more or greater ones. If we are faithful in that which is little, he will place us over that which is great. That, however, must come from him, and not be the result of our efforts. Let us leave it to him and curl ourselves up in our shells."
