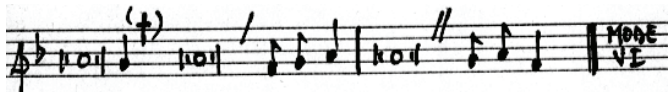

Last week's Answer: St Peter and St Paul. St Peter was given the keys to the kingdom. He alone was given this unique gift which would enable him to be the first pope. St Paul is traditionally credited with writing 13 of the 27 New Testament books (thus the book) and was killed by having his head cut off (thus the sword). St Paul was a Roman citizen and could not be killed within the city walls. St Peter and St Paul share a birthday into heaven – June 29.

Trivia – St Vincent de Paul's Life and Times:

As St Vincent de Paul neared the end of his life, his spiritual sons kept a close eye on him. For many months, he was not able to leave his room. He was not able to receive visitors. Letters to him were carefully monitored. This situation made things very difficult for St Louise de Marillac. She had many things to consult him about concerning the Daughters of Charity. She needed answers about what to do in certain circumstances. She also longed to speak with him about things going on in her own life. She feared placing another burden on him, but still she wrote him letters because of the seriousness of the situation with his spiritual children. Let us not be afraid to seek the help we need!
