



BLESSED SEBASTIAN VALFRE

"When it is all over you will not regret having suffered; rather you will regret having suffered so little, and suffered that little so badly."

Bl Sebastian was born on March 9, 1629 to a humble and poor family. He remained poor throughout his life in the Congregation of the Oratory at Turin. At the Oratory he wished simply to serve the people of God in whatever capacity he was given, whether in pastoral work, house administration, scholarly pursuits, or sweeping the stairs. He would as happily go to the death beds of the poor or the Royal family of Savoy. Most of his life was spent wandering around the streets and squares simply being available, speaking of God's love for all men and of the love that we should have for each other. The Apostle of Turin died on January 30, 1710. He was beatified by Pope Gregory XVI in 1834. *There will be a Sung Mass at Holy Family Church on Tuesday, January 30 at 5:30 p.m.*

100TH ANNIVERSARY CORNER

In honour of the centenary of our parish church (September 2023-September 2024), we are inviting all parishioners to rediscover the power of the rosary. Join us as we try to pray the rosary each day in our church.

Does the <u>Catechism of the Catholic Church</u> (CCC) mention the Rosary? Yes.

CCC 971 "All generations will call me blessed": "The Church's devotion to the Blessed Virgin is intrinsic to Christian worship" (Lk 1:48; Paul VI, Marialis cultus, 56.) The Church rightly honors "the Blessed Virgin with special devotion. From the most ancient times the Blessed Virgin has been honored with the title of 'Mother of God,' to whose protection the faithful fly in all their dangers and needs.... This very special devotion ... differs essentially from the adoration which is given to the incarnate Word and equally to the Father and the Holy Spirit, and greatly fosters this adoration" (Lumen Gentium 66). The liturgical feasts dedicated to the Mother of God and Marian prayer, such as the rosary, an "epitome of the whole Gospel," express this devotion to the Virgin Mary (Cf. Paul VI, Marialis cultus, 42; SC 103).

Why did Pope St Paul VI on 2 February 1974 call the Rosary the epitome of the Gospel?

An "epitome" is an abridgement, a summary. The rosary is a perfect summary of the life of Christ, the main subject of the Gospels. The rosary allows us to follow the life of Christ by the eyes of Mary, the primary witness.
