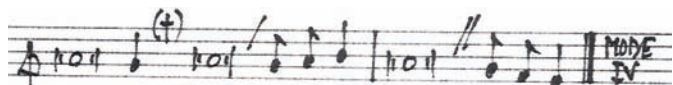

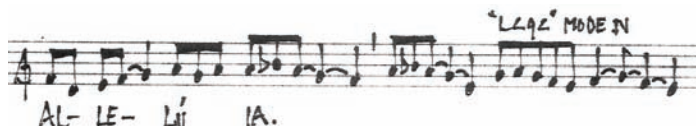

100TH ANNIVERSARY CORNER

As we begin this new year, we have been focusing on the Rosary of the Blessed Virgin Mary. Why? From September 2023-September 2024, we are celebrating the centenary of our church. This year marks the 100th anniversary of the first Christmas and Lent and Easter in our church. As God blessed this church 100 years ago, we ask him to bless us in this year. We are asking Him to renew this parish with powerful graces just as He built this church so powerfully.

But God's work of building His Church, the Body of Christ, began with Mary. As sin began with a woman, so salvation begins with a woman. In this year of renewal, we want to imitate God. We want to start with Mary. Through her Christ first came into the world. Through her prayers, the Holy Spirit was sent at Pentecost.

For centuries the Church has found the rosary to be the best effective way for individuals and groups to grow closer to Christ through Mary. But where do we find in the Scriptures a basis for such confidence in Mary? John 2 and John 20.

The Catechism of the Catholic Church 2618 explains: *"The Gospel reveals to us how Mary prays and intercedes in faith. At Cana, the mother of Jesus asks her son for the needs of a wedding feast; this is the sign of another feast - that of the wedding of the Lamb where he gives his body and blood at the request of the Church, his Bride. It is at the hour of the New Covenant, at the foot of the cross, that Mary is heard as the Woman, the new Eve, the true "Mother of all the living."*
