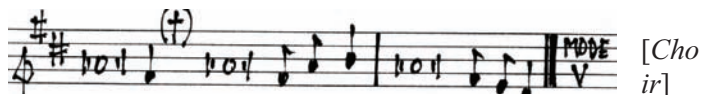

The Lenten Season is, by long tradition, the time when Catechumens make their final preparation for Baptism at the Easter Vigil. Seven catechumens from our parish participated in the Rite of Election last Sunday at St Michael's Cathedral Basilica. They will be going through the Scrutinies on the Third, Fourth and Fifth Sundays of Lent, March 3, 10 and 17 at the 11 a.m. Mass. (It is possible that two or three of them will do the Scrutinies at Holy Family, but they will be baptized here.)

100TH ANNIVERSARY CORNER

100k for 100 years

Our plans to renovate the parish hall are continuing, as is our fundraising for the project. We have a promise of **matching donations up to \$100,000** towards the work of making our parish hall a wonderful place for receptions, family events, and social and cultural gatherings, not to mention our famous Pope and Doctor Pub and annual Ceili. Your donation for the work on the hall will be doubled, and if we can raise \$100,000, this will mean \$200,000 with the matching donations. This will be more than enough to cover the cost of the renovations, and give us the beginnings of a Centenary Fund for other updates and repairs to the parish plant. It was suggested at the Finance Council meeting that if we had one hundred donors who could give one thousand dollars each, we would be well on the way to financing the project. That was *before* the matching donors came up with their generous offer. So far we have received \$25,675 from parish donors plus the first matching gift of \$10,000. The other \$15,675 *will* be matched.

Can you give \$1,000 for our hall renovation fund? Or a multiple thereof? Whatever you give will be **doubled** up to the first \$100,000 in total donations. Please be sure to indicate that your donation is for the Hall Renovation Fund.

We are trying to do this work with a minimal amount of disruption, and we are working with the various groups that use the hall so that they can make adjustments if necessary. We are very happy to have a number of 12-step groups who meet at our parish, and are grateful for their understanding. This week may be the most trying for them.
