100TH ANNIVERSARY CORNER

Kirby Hall Kickoff!

On December 30, 1930, the first pastor, the beloved Fr Lancelot Minehan, for whom the organ was donated, for whom several windows in the church were donated, passed into eternal life. Fr Minehan “suffered a stroke at 266 Roncesvalles Ave, was taken to St Joseph’s hospital, and died at 9 p.m. the same day” (50th anniversary Commemorative booklet). The people of St Vincent’s were devastated.

Who could take over this remarkable young parish on Roncesvalles? Who could carry on the beautiful liturgical life of this parish, the successful vocation culture already present, the athletic teams, the social events, and the spiritual formation of many holy people? The Archbishop decided that he had to send the rector of the Cathedral! He sent Fr Gerard Kirby.

While he was rector of St Michael’s, Fr Kirby was given the highest tributes by those who worked with him. Under his leadership, for example, St Michael’s Cathedral was the first church in North America to broadcast services over the radio. Fr Kirby was enthusiastic, intelligent, and a great administrator.

Fr Kirby already had a doctorate from the Pontifical Institute of Medieval Studies. He taught at St Augustine’s Seminary. But the bishop considered St Vincent’s to be such an important parish, such a potentially fruitful source of vocations and holiness, that he sent one of the most trusted and talented priests to succeed Fr Minehan. Fr Kirby would prove as beloved as Fr Minehan. We have a parish hall built by and named after two faithful priests. Our parish was built by these two men Christ, the true Foundation Stone.

On Tuesday, March 19 we officially launched our capital campaign (Foundation Stone: Parish Hall Renovation Project) to raise money to renovate Kirby Hall. Fr Daniel announced that we had just surpassed the \$50,000 mark in terms of donations. We are halfway to our goal! The kickoff event was an evening of joy. Delicious food was provided by the Social Committee and Real Empanada!

All day long we celebrated St Joseph – inside and outside the church! Significant numbers of people prayed before Our Lord in the monstrance. And even more people visited the food tent to buy hot chocolate and empanadas! Thank you to all our benefactors. Thank you to the school and their students and teachers and staff. Thank you to our graphic designers! Thank you to our volunteers who are helping to make this hall grow in beauty and usefulness. Do we realize how important St Vincent’s is and is meant to be? St Joseph, pray for us!
