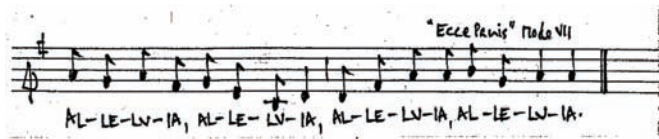

100TH ANNIVERSARY CORNER

Who is the bearded priest whose image is below the statue of Mary? And what is in the box in front of his picture? The priest is St Philip Neri (1515-1595), the second Apostle of Rome. As God sent St Peter to be the first Apostle of Rome when faith in Christ was first planted there, so God sent St Philip to Rome to make sure faith in Christ did not end in Rome. St Philip was raised up to renew and revitalize Rome in the 16th century. When people were saying that to be a Christian one had to leave the Catholic Church, when people were saying that the Holy Spirit could only be found outside Rome, God said the opposite through St Philip Neri. St Philip worked for the reform of the Church by staying within the Church. He prayed for his own conversion and carried out a life of penance before setting out to convert others.

While St Philip's work, his main mission, was the reconversion of Romans by the use of the confessional and spiritual talks, his life resulted in a new community of priests and brothers. Without aiming at starting a new spiritual family in the Church, St Philip's obedience to divine Providence led to the founding of the Oratory in 1575. Four hundred years later, in 1975, this band of brothers came to Canada! In 1995, the fourth centenary of St Philip's death, divine Providence led the Oratorians to take over St Vincent de Paul church. Over the past 30 years, the Oratorians, the spiritual sons of St Philip, have been the pastors here at our parish.

In 2022, on the 400th anniversary of St Philip's being declared a saint, the image of St Philip and relics of St Philip were placed on Our Lady's altar. The first relic is a piece of his clothing, possibly from an alb he used at Mass. The reliquary is from the 17th century. Before that reliquary is a relic crucifix that has been splayed open. Inside the cross is a small fragment of St Philip's bone.

St Philip died on May 26. He is buried at the Chiesa Nuova in Rome, the original Oratorian church, a church he built. As St Philip wanted every altar in the church to be dedicated to a mystery of the life of Mary, so it is fitting that his image and relics are beneath our statue of Mary. St Philip and St Vincent are a powerful team of priestly intercessors in heaven. Let us pray this Monday for all the priests who serve at St Vincent!

This year, because St Philip's day falls on Sunday, it's transferred to Monday. Please join with the Fathers and Brothers of the Oratory as we celebrate the feast day of our holy Founder, St. Philip Neri on Monday, May 27, there will be a Solemn High Mass at 6:00 p.m. at Holy Family Church.

Next Tuesday, May 28, we will have another full day of Eucharistic adoration in response to Our Lady's statue being vandalized. What does Our Lady want the most? She wants people to know and love her Son. Come and adore Him!

While we pray inside the church, the centenary food market continues outside the Church. Support the St Joseph Jubilee market!
