**100TH ANNIVERSARY CORNER**

When is the waterproofing to begin? Due to delays in a previous project, the company waterproofing our church basement pushed back our project for two weeks. The work will now begin on August 6.

Let us ask Our Lady to look after this part of our Foundation Stone endeavor! Our parish church has a special connection to Our Lady. The cornerstone of our church was laid on August 15, 1915. Fr Minehan began work on our church on the anniversary of Our Lady's Assumption into heaven. Our Lady is a type, an image of the whole Church. Like Mary, the Church is a mother and a spouse. She is the mother of a multitude of believers and spouse of Christ Jesus. Like the Blessed Virgin, the Church is virginal and pure in her faith towards God. On behalf of the whole Church, Our Lady said the proposal of God for the union of

humanity and divinity in Christ Jesus. Our Lady represented the Church at the foot of the Cross. Our Lady was there at Pentecost, the only woman named, when the Holy Spirit was poured forth and the Church burst forth from the Upper Room. As the symbol, the representative, the type, the prefigurement, the image of the Church herself, it was fitting for Our Lady to be assumed body and soul into heaven.

We believe in the resurrection of the body. We believe that at the end of time, when Christ returns in glory, all those who have died will be raised up. Those who believed and hoped in and loved Christ will take their place body and soul in heaven. God wanted Our Lady to point the whole Church to our future state. She experienced what all Christians will experience. In her, God shows the Church what she is meant to be.

Let us pray a little novena for the successful completion of our waterproofing project. Let us pray for the company doing the work. Their name is Cornerstone Waterproofing. Let us pray the following prayer every day for nine days from August 6-14. Leading up to the anniversary of our cornerstone being laid, we will pray that Cornerstone will help make our church stand strong for another 100 years.
