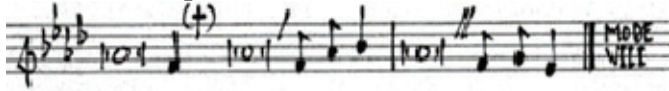

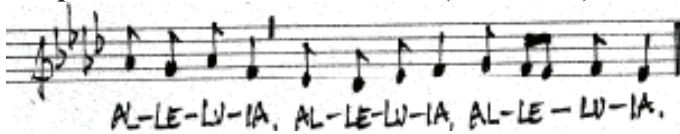

## 100TH ANNIVERSARY CORNER

On August 15, 1915 Archbishop McNeil of Toronto came to St Vincent de Paul for the laying of the official foundation stone, the corner-stone, of our church. Digging for our church had begun in April 1915. The basement church was finished in October 1915 with the Archbishop returning for the dedication of the basement church on October 24, 1915.

Why was August 15 chosen? August 15 is the anniversary of Our Lady's assumption into heaven. Our Lord loved his Mother so much that he did not want her body to see decay. He wanted her body to share in the happiness of heaven.

Our Lady is the image of the Church. And our church, our physical church, is also a symbol of the Church. Our Lady is a living prefigurement and embodiment of the Church. Our church building is itself not alive, but it is meant to be beautiful and be a place where Christ dwells.

In other words, as God built a house for his Son when he formed Mary in this world, so He built a house for his Son when he provided for our parish church. Laying the foundation stone on the Assumption directs our minds to how our parish church must model herself on Mary. We must imitate Mary. We must seek to be with her in this life and in eternal life.

Our basement church had its corner-stone laid on August 15, the Assumption of Mary. The basement church was dedicated in the month of Mary, October. Let us keep asking Our Lady to guide and protect us.

## **Special Funeral**

On Thursday, August 8, the funeral of Fr Leo Ramsperger took place in our church. Fr Leo was born on February 25, 1924 and baptized on March 9, 1924 in St Vincent de Paul Church by our founding Pastor, Fr Lancelot Minehan. He was the fourth of twelve (or more?) children in a family that lived on Howard Park Avenue. He went to St Vincent's School and made his First Communion and Confirmation in our church. Grant him eternal rest, O Lord, and let perpetual light shine upon him. May his soul, and the souls of all the faithful departed, through the mercy of God, rest in peace.
