



# QUEENSHIP OF THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY

Pope Pius XII in the Papal Encyclical *Ad Coeli Reginam* proposed the traditional doctrine on the Queenship of Mary and established this feast for the Universal Church. This feast day is celebrated on August 22.

"Turning her maternal Heart toward us and dealing with the affair of our salvation, she is concerned with the whole human race. Constituted by the Lord Queen of Heaven and earth, and exalted above all choirs of Angels and the ranks of Saints in Heaven, standing at the right hand of Her only-begotten Son, Our Lord Jesus Christ, she petitions most powerfully with Her maternal prayers, and she obtains what she seeks." - Pope Pius IX

#### **100TH ANNIVERSARY CORNER**

On August 8, the traditional feast of **St John Vianney**, **patron saint of priests**, we had the funeral Mass for Fr Leo Ramsperger. Fr Leo was 100 years old and was baptized at St Vincent's by our first pastor, Fr Lancelot Minehan. At the end of July, our current pastor, Fr Daniel Utrecht, was called to hospital to administer the Anointing of the Sick (Extreme Unction) to Fr Leo. Fr Daniel had been told that Fr Leo was not responsive and was not eating. After anointing him, Fr Daniel asked Fr Leo if he wanted to receive Viaticum. Fr Leo suddenly opened his eyes and nodded. When Fr Daniel said, "The Body of Christ," Fr Leo quietly said, "Amen," and opened his mouth to receive Our Lord on the tongue. On August 2, Fr Leo passed into eternal life after 70 years of being a priest.

Leo Ramsperger received his first sacrament from the pastor of St Vincent's. He received his final sacraments from the pastor of St Vincent. The first pastor baptized him; the current pastor anointed him and gave him viaticum. Viaticum means "food for the journey (via)." Viaticum is our nourishment for the final passage from this life to eternity, from this world to the Father. The Eucharist is the "seed of eternal life and the power of the resurrection" (*CCC* 1524).

When St John Vianney was dying and the priests came to bring him viaticum, with tears in his eyes, St John said, "How sad it is to receive Holy Communion for the last time." How blessed we are to have the example of St John Vianney. How blessed we are to have had the example of Fr Leo. Having his funeral on the feast of St John Vianney is a sign that Fr Leo was a good and holy priest. Let us pray for God to raise up more priests from this parish. As St John Vianney liked to say:

"The priest continues the work of redemption on earth . . . if we really understood the priest on earth, we would die not of fright but of love . . . the Priesthood is the love of the heart of Jesus" (CCC 1559).
