#### **100TH ANNIVERSARY CORNER**

Work on waterproofing the foundation of our church continues. Little did we realize when we decided to campaign fundraising give our the FOUNDATION STONE how appropriate that name would prove to be. Our fellow parishioners from the foundation of this parish provided a good foundation to the church. It is up to us to make sure it stays in good condition for the generations that will follow us. In our work on the parish hall, we discovered a need to waterproof the south wall of the foundation of the church, where there has been some water damage. During that work, a new discovery was made, adding to the cost: what was the 'basement church' for the first nine years of the parish's life had straightforward straight walls, which are the original foundation of the church. When the 'upper church' was built, it included confessionals which jut out from the north and south walls. Footings were put in to support those confessionals, but they were not tied in to the full depth of the rest of the foundation. In order to seal the wall fully, we need to stabilize the support of those footings, pour more concrete, and waterproof that concrete. If you can help with financing that work, God bless you.
