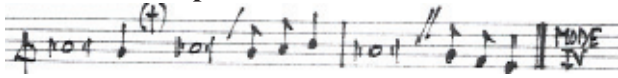

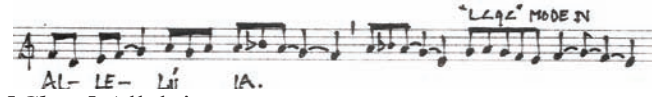

YEAR OF PRAYER – CORNER

The *Catechism of the Catholic Church* speaks of prayer in the following way: "a vital and personal relationship with the living and true God" (CCC 2558). Prayer is vital to us, essential to our existence as followers of Christ.

By faith we accept the revelation of God as three divine Persons. By the sacraments, above all the Mass, we share in the life of the Trinity by being raised up as children of God. The sacraments enable us, empower us, to act as children of God and witnesses to Christ's saving love. But the moral life, imitating Christ, requires an ongoing relationship with God our Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Spirit.
