



ST. JOHN HENRY CARDINAL NEWMAN

John Henry Newman (1801-1890) was an Anglican clergyman and a teacher at Oxford University. In 1845, on October 9, at the age of 44, he became a Roman Catholic and soon after was ordained a priest. He established the first Oratory of St. Philip Neri in the English-speaking world. A theologian and Church historian, he devoted his life to Catholic education, pastoral work and writing. He was named a cardinal by Leo XIII, in 1879. He died August 11, 1890. On September 19, 2010 he was beatified by Pope Benedict XVI, and Pope Francis canonized him on October 13, 2019. There will be a sung English Mass on Wednesday, October 9 at 5:30 p.m. at Holy Family.

YEAR OF PRAYER - CORNER

When we pray the Rosary, the most common prayer is the Hail Mary. We say it fifty times. The first word is taken from the Annunciation in St Luke's Gospel. The angel Gabriel entered the house of Mary and said: Ave, Hail. This greeting is very unique in the Scriptures. Normally when angels appear to humanity they are the ones greeted. Human beings show respect for the angels and their superior power by greeting them. Think of Abraham and the three angels in the book of Genesis. But in the Annunciation, the reverse happens. An angel greets a human person first. The angel is thus telling us that Mary is greater. How? Not by her natural powers of mind and heart. Mary is greater by God's gift of grace. She is the Immaculate Conception. She was brought into the world to be the mother of the Saviour. In order to say yes to this mission, in order to become the Mother of all Christ's disciples, she was given unique gifts of grace that elevated her above the highest angels. We praise Mary every time we say the Hail Mary!
