YEAR OF PRAYER – CORNER

Holy Mary, Mother of God.

In our ongoing meditation on the Hail Mary, the most frequent prayer of the rosary, we come to the words, Holy Mary, Mother of God. Until this point, the words of the Hail Mary are all taken from Scripture. They were taken from the greetings of Gabriel and Elizabeth. In the second half of the prayer, the Church speaks to the Blessed Virgin in words that are her own.

We call her, Holy. She is Holy because she is like God. She is free of all sin. She is called Mary because this was the name her parents gave her. Her name is like a sacrament. When we call upon her name, she draws near to us. Her name gives us access to the person of the Blessed Virgin. We use the name that St Joseph himself used. We use the name that Jesus used when people asked him the name of his parents.

In Advent, we especially delight to think of Mary as pregnant. She is the Mother of God because the child she conceived is the eternal Son of God. In time, God the Son truly came to earth. The Person, the One, who dwelt in Mary's womb is God from God.
