

#### JUBILEE YEAR - CORNER

On December 24, 2024, the Pope inaugurated the Holy Year of 2025. At the vigil of the Saviour's birth, the Pope opened the holy door at St Peter's basilica. The pope is inviting all Catholics to visit Rome and pass through these special doors. In the Papal Bull announcing this Holy Year, the Pope said: "the Holy Door will be flung open to invite everyone to an intense experience of the love of God that awakens in hearts the sure hope of salvation in Christ" (Spes non confundit, 6).

But how can passing through a door in Rome help one experience the love of God?

The church of St Peter's, the principal church in the world, represents the Body of Christ. The holy door at St Peter's is a symbol of the wounds in Our Lord's Body, especially in the side of Christ. The wound in his side is the pathway to his heart, the symbol of God's love. Passing through a Holy Door symbolizes passing through the side of Christ to reach his Love.

Christ and his Church cannot be separated. When Saul was on his way to Damascus to persecute the Church, Christ appeared to him and asked, "Saul, Saul, why do you persecute me?" (Acts 9:4). The Church as the Body of Christ prolongs Christ's presence in the world. Through his Church, built on the foundation of St Peter, the first Pope, we know Christ and his Love.

For centuries, the Popes have established the Holy Years every 25 years. The first Holy Year in 1300 was meant to commemorate the great Holy Year, the year of Christ's birth. The Pope realized that the Church needed to be renewed in her commitment to the Incarnation. Gradually these Holy Years were celebrated at least every 25 years. 25 years marks each new generation. Each generation is called to rediscover Christ in His Church as centred in Rome. Each generation is called to bring Christ's redemption to the whole world. Pope Francis opened the Holy Door at the celebration of Christ's birth because he wants all of humanity to enter Christ's Church to experience God's love.

In 1470 Pope Paul II added the title Jubilee to these special Holy Years. In the Scriptures, a Jubilee year called "for acts of clemency and liberation that enable new beginnings" (*Spes non confundit*, 10; cf. Leviticus 25 and Luke 4). Inspired by the wisdom of the Scriptures, Jubilee Holy Years are meant to bring about reconciliation with Christ. By calling this year a Jubilee of Hope, the Pope hopes for greater reconciliation with the world's Redeemer. He wants us all to go to confession. He wants us all to do penance. He wants us to seek indulgences. The main way to celebrate the Holy Year is to go to confession! The soul of the Jubilee is the spirit of penance. The joy of the Jubilee is to gain many indulgences.

The main way to gain a plenary indulgence in this Holy Year, this Jubilee of 2025, is to go to Rome! But as the Pope realizes this is not possible for most people, he establishes churches in each diocese as a place of pilgrimage. The principal Church in Toronto is St Michael's Cathedral Basilica! Let us make a pilgrimage to St Michael's, the symbol of Christ's Body the Church in this city.
