

ORATORY SUMMER SCHOOL

Registration for the annual Oratory Summer School has opened. There are two sessions available. The first session offers a systematic introduction to The Catechism of The Catholic Church. The second session takes Jubilee Years as its theme, converging appropriately with 2025 being celebrated as a Jubilee Year in the universal Church and with the Toronto Oratory's own 50th anniversary, for St. Philip himself directed a confraternity dedicated to the care of Jubilee pilgrims in Rome. We shall study, among other topics, the theology and history of jubilees, Saint Philip's special association with Jubilees and the theme of the Church's Jubilee this year: Pilgrims of Hope. The first session will be July 7 to 11 and the second session July 14 to 18. The cost for each session, which includes lunch each day for those attending in person, is \$200 per person. For those attending online, the cost is \$175 per person. Accommodation is available in the seminary for \$100 per person, which covers the entire week. Oratory Corner

In 1995, the Archdiocese of Toronto asked the Oratorians to become the pastors of St Vincent de Paul church. This year is the thirtieth anniversary of the Fathers of the Toronto Oratory being at St Vincent de Paul. 2025 is also the fiftieth anniversary of the Toronto Oratory.

The Oratory means a little house of prayer. My house, the Lord said, will be a house of prayer. Domus mea Domus Orationis Vocabitur. In 1575, God inspired St Philip Neri to found the Oratory, a congregation of priests and brothers who devote themselves first and foremost to prayer. Prayer is speaking with God, conversation with God. In order to remind his sons and those they serve about the primacy of prayer, St Philip called the congregation “the Oratory.” Besides prayer, the Oratorians devote themselves to the administration of the Sacraments, especially confession, and the daily distribution of the Word of God.

Oratorians do not change houses. They stay in one place their whole life. This is why the same group of priests have been around St Vincent's for so long. The stability of the Oratorians allows them to stay close to the flock entrusted to them. Last week, for example, we hosted an anniversary party for Fr Daniel. One of the ladies helping to organize the party had received first communion from Fr Daniel over twenty years ago. Please pray in this month of May for the Oratorians. May is the month of the true founder, the Blessed Virgin Mary. May is also the month of St Philip's feast day, May 26.
