POPE LEO XIV! – CANADIAN CONNECTION

Thank you to all who were praying for our new Pope. Thank you to all who were asking St Philip Neri, Apostle of Rome and Patron saint of Rome, to obtain a holy and wise pope.

On May 8, the feast of the Augustian, Bl Catherine of St Augustine, an Augustian was elected as the 266th successor of St Peter. Bl Catherine was the spiritual mother, the spiritual support, for the Church in North America. When the first bishop was sent to Quebec City in 1659, his jurisdiction covered all of present-day North America, excluding California and some colonies on the East Coast of the present USA. His diocese included Chicago, the birth place of our new Holy Father. As St Francois de Laval was trying to govern this large area and provide missionary priests, Bl Catherine was praying and offering her life as a victim for this new church.

She prayed for the future of the Church in North America. She saw herself as a holocaust, a victim of love for the Church in this land. She "offered her life for the Church and the salvation of New France." Did she see far into the future? As far as Pope Leo XIV? We do not know.

What we know is that we have a new Holy Father from the same spiritual family as Bl. Catherine. We know they both are dedicated to St Augustine. We know that he became the Pope on her feast day, her birthday into heaven. We know that she dedicated her life to this land, the land from which Pope Leo was born.
