

50th Anniversary -- Oratory Corner

The Oratory means a little house of prayer. The Latin root of Oratory is *orare*, *to speak*. An "orator" literally means one who speaks. A man like Fulton Sheen was a great "orator" because he made good speeches.

But we can also speak to God. A place set apart, a place where we speak to God, is called an Oratory. We can build an oratory in our homes. We can have a little room for prayer, for speaking with the Lord.

What is the difference between an oratory and a chapel? We often speak of such prayer rooms as chapels. But chapel comes from a word that means cape. It seems that the room holding the cape of St Martin of Tours first got the name chapel, Chappelle in French. The calling of a small place for prayer a chapel then spread.

In Italy, however, such small places of prayer were called oratorios, oratories. And St Philip Neri wanted to people to speak to God. He wanted laymen and laywomen to speak to God. He built a room, an Oratory, for people to gather in Rome for prayer. When he formed a group of priests and brothers into a body, a congregation, for helping people get closer to God, he called it "the Oratory." He wanted his sons to always remember their main obligation: prayer. We are to be men of prayer. We are to help people be grow in prayer.

As Fr Robinson liked to say: we are meant to help people remember the reality of the reality of God. And we have a way to make contact with God: prayer. God is not an impersonal force. God is a person. God is, in fact, three Persons. God seeks our friendship. God seeks a living and personal relationship with each of us. That living and personal relationship with the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit is called prayer.

Why is there an Oratory in Toronto?

In 1975, St Philip's way of life was introduced into Canada by Fr Jonathan Robinson. Converted to Christ by an experience of the Lord, an undeniable encounter with God, Fr Robinson tried to draw others to this unseen relationship with God. He thought the best way for him to help others was to start an Oratory of St Philip Neri. The Oratory would foster prayer and love for Christ in modern cities. A stable, well-rounded, and highly educated group of priests could do much good if fixed in one place and dedicated to prayer, the sacraments, and preaching.

Five years ago, on June 3, 2020, Fr Robinson passed into eternal life. He faithfully guided the Oratory in Canada for almost fifty years. This Saturday we are commemorating his fifth anniversary of death.

On Saturday June 7, at 10.30 am, there will be a Mass at the graveside of our founder, Fr Jonathan Robinson, followed by a picnic at the nearby Island Lake Conservation Area. We have reserved two buses so that parishioners without cars can attend, which will leave Holy Family at 9 am and return here around 6 pm. Please sign up here and indicate if you are
