



#### CHANGE AND CONTINUITY

As of Wednesday, June 25, Fr Daniel Utrecht will cease to be the pastor of St Vincent de Paul and Fr Martin Hilbert will become the new pastor. So, the two of us are, in effect, just switching places, as per the Archdiocesan policy which limits the terms for pastors to twelve years in one parish. As in the past, you will see us both in both parishes along with all the other Fathers and Brothers of the Oratory, which is the real source of the continuity.

#### July 7 – 11: The Catechism of The Catholic Church July 14 – 18: Jubilee Year in the universal Church

Registration for the annual Oratory Summer School has opened. There are two sessions available. The first session offers a systematic introduction to The Catechism of The Catholic Church. The second session takes Jubilee Years as its theme, converging appropriately with 2025 being celebrated as a Jubilee Year in the universal Church and with the Toronto Oratory's own 50th anniversary, for St. Philip himself directed a confraternity dedicated to the care of Jubilee pilgrims in Rome. We shall study, among other topics, the theology and history of jubilees, Saint Philip's special association with Jubilees and the theme of the Church's Jubilee this year: Pilgrims of Hope. The cost for each session, which includes lunch each day for those attending in person, is \$200 per person. For those attending online, the cost is \$175 per person. On October 6, 1975, the Holy See approved the establishment of the Oratory of St Philip Neri in Canada. On November 1, this decision was communicated to Fr Jonathan Robinson, thus establishing the Oratorians in our country. This year, we are doing various things to mark our **golden anniversary**.

Thank you to all who attended the Mass at the grave of Fr Jonathan Robinson on June 7. Thank you to all who helped with the BBQ lunch at the Orangeville Reservoir. People are already asking if we will have a similar event next year to remember the founder of the Toronto Oratory!

St Philip Neri wanted to help lay people be saints in their own homes. He wanted to build up authentic community in the Church. On this *Corpus Christi Sunday*, dedicated to the Body and Blood of Christ, let us pray for the mission of the Oratorians.

Their work is threefold: *prayer*, *administering the sacraments, and preaching the daily word of God*. Their mission centres on the Holy Eucharist, the Word of God Himself and our daily spiritual food. In the Eucharist, Christ prolongs His prayer to the Father in the Holy Spirit.
