



Frequently, announced Masses are booked well in advance, but at the moment we have a number of openings for Masses in the very near future. #### SHRINES OF CANADA

*There are many shrines in Canada which are not too far to drive for a family trip.* 

St. Anne de Beaupre Basilica receives 1.5 million pilgrims each year to show their devotion to St. Anne, the mother of the Virgin Mary.

St. Anne was the spouse of St. Joachim, and was chosen by God to be the mother of Mary, His own blessed Mother on earth. The names of Joachim and Anne are not found in the Bible, but are found in a second century text known as the Gospel of James. According to this apocryphal work, their lives were wholly occupied in prayer and good works, but they suffered from childlessness. Through a message from an angel they learned that God would bless them with a daughter.

Devotion to St Anne as mother of the Blessed Virgin Mary and grandmother of our Lord grew through the centuries. St Francois de Laval and other founders of the Church in Canada had a great devotion to the Holy Family, so it is not surprising that great shrines to St Anne and St Joseph are to be found in Quebec. The church of St Joachim, not far from Beaupre, dates back to the 1770s.
