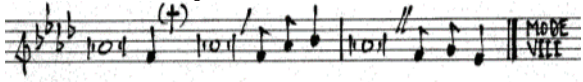

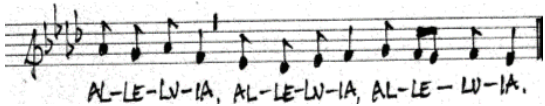

Besides the Gala, other events are marking this jubilee!

In honour of the 50th anniversary of the founding of the Toronto Oratory, a group of parishioners made a pilgrimage to Quebec. They visited places connected to the foundation of the Toronto Oratory (the original house in Montreal, the Benedictine monastery that supported Fr Robinson, and the grave of Fr Robinson's own father).

But the pilgrimage also focused on seeing other founders and foundations for the Church in Canada. "The Foundation of the Church in Canada," St Vincent de Paul once said, "is one of the most remarkable achievements of fifteen centuries." These words of our patron saint are well worth pondering. He is not just saying that our country is blessed. He is saying that in all the history of the Church, it is hard to find things as remarkable as in Canada. St Vincent had in mind the great founders of the Church (St Francois, St Marie of the Incarnation, and Bl Catherine of St Augustine). But he also had in mind the Franciscan missionaries who arrived in 1615 and especially the Jesuit missionaries, the North American Martyrs.

The Jesuits arrived in 1625. They left for a few years due to English occupation. They returned in 1632 and fully replaced the Franciscans. The Jesuits had a house in Quebec City. They sent missionaries down the St Lawrence. Their main centre of operations was in what is now Midland, Ontario. Fr Martin Hilbert just led a walking pilgrimage there. Cardinal Leo is inviting parishioners from around the diocese to the shrine on August 24.

One of the missionaries who lived in Quebec and in Midland was St Isaac Jogues. He had been captured by the Iroquois and tortured. After his escape and his return to France, he was sent back to the Canadian mission. "Jogues felt urged to return to the Iroquois, knowing that he would not return alive. He wrote, "the Iroquois people are to me a spouse of blood. I have sealed the alliance in my blood. When he was in Quebec, he spent a great part of the day before the Blessed Sacrament. He heard as many Masses as possible. He said he felt no devotion, but he wanted to make up for the times he would not be able to say Mass and to forestall all the Masses he would not be able to say. One of his companions summarizes it all saying, 'his soul was glued to the Blessed Sacrament.'" (Cardinal Journet, Marie of the Incarnation Correspondence, 1-2).

May St Isaac Jogues pray for us to be a little more glued to the Blessed Sacrament. May he help us know how to make up for lost opportunities despite all lack of feelings. We still live in this land that has such a remarkable foundation. From the Eucharist alone can it remain remarkable.
