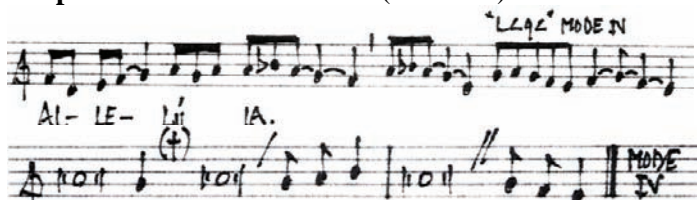

ORATORY CORNER

During this coming month, we will be celebrating the 50th anniversary of the founding of the Toronto Oratory. October 2 marks the opening of these celebrations. The month will end with a Solemn High Mass on November 1 at Holy Family. Other events will also take place.

Who is the founder of the Oratory? Normally we say, St Philip Neri. But St Philip used to say that Our Lady was the true founder. St Philip did not intend to start a new community of priests in the church. He did not intend to revive an ancient form of priestly life in which priests and brothers live in one place, but without vows. He did not intend to start a worldwide congregation. What he realized is that Our Lady was guiding his life. He realized that events beyond his control resulted in this new congregation. At its beginning, the Pope gave the Oratorians the church of Santa Maria in Vallicella.

This church in Rome has Our Lady's nativity (September 8) as its patronal feast day. September 8 is also the feast of Our Lady of Roncesvalles in Spain. There is this connection between our parish and the origin of the Oratory. Next year, perhaps we can honour Our Lady of Roncesvalles in some special way on September 8. St Vincent de Paul is also connected with the Oratorians in another way. In 1995 they began caring for our parish. That year was the 400 anniversary of the death of St Philip. Please pray for our priests as they celebrate 50 years as a community.
