

October 6 is the 50th anniversary of the Holy See's official signing of the decree establishing the Oratory in Canada. This decree came into effect on All Saints Day, November 1 when it was communicated by the Procurator General of the Oratory to Fr Jonathan Robinson. On Monday, October 6, there will be a Sung English Mass at 5:30 p.m. at Holy Family Church.

There will also be a sung English Mass on Thursday, October 9 at 5:30 p.m. at Holy Family for the feast of St John Henry Newman. During that Mass, our Brother Jeffrey Sullivan, C.O. will receive the ministry of acolyte, setting him apart for special service at altar beside the priest and deacon. Please pray for Br Jeffrey!

ST. ALOYSIUS SCROSOPPI, PRAY FOR US!!

Aloysius (Luigi) Scrosoppi (1804-1884) helped establish the Oratorians in Udine, Italy, his native city in the northeast of Italy. He is a model for those who live in times of political upheavals. On more than one occasion governments suppressed the Oratory in Udine. He is the founder of the Sisters of Providence, whose work it was to help orphans. These sisters are now active in many parts of the world. But the miracle which paved the way for his canonization was in favour of an Oratorian novice in South Africa who was dying of AIDS. The feast day of St Aloysius Scrosoppi is October 5. We are transferring his feast to October 6.

ST. JOHN HENRY CARDINAL NEWMAN

John Henry Newman (1801-1890) was an Anglican clergyman and a teacher at Oxford University. In 1845, on October 9, at the age of 44, he became a Roman Catholic and soon after was ordained a priest. He established the first Oratory of St. Philip Neri in the English-speaking world. A theologian and Church historian, he devoted his life to Catholic education, pastoral work and writing. He was named a cardinal by Leo XIII, in 1879. He died August 11, 1890. On September 19, 2010 he was beatified by Pope Benedict XVI, and Pope Francis canonized him on October 13, 2019.

Update: Pope Leo XIV has announced that on All Saints Day, November 1, he will solemnly declare St John Henry Newman a doctor of the Church. Newman will be the 38th doctor of the Church. A doctor of the Church is a saintly teacher, set apart by God as a spiritual guide for the whole Church. St John Henry is especially important for his teaching on conscience as the voice of God in relation to the Church, on the relationship between faith and reason, and the development of doctrine. But St John Henry also wrote two novels. He wrote poetry. His sermons are famous. What a glorious gift on our 50th anniversary day!
