

ORATORY CORNER

All Saints Day is a reminder that the Church consists not only those on earth. The Church includes those in heaven. The Church is the gathering of all those who are saved in Christ. In the letter to the Romans, St Paul says that *in one man, all sinned*. He is talking about the sin of Adam. We were all united in a mysterious way to the first man. He was meant to hand on to us his original justice and holiness. We were connected to him. When he sinned, we, like the parts of a whole, also lost grace.

But as sin reigned through one man, so grace has abounded all the more. God's plan was to send his Son as a man. The Son united to his divine person every human person. He lived and died and rose and ascended for us. Through his obedience, we have been saved.

But Christ not only united us to Himself as our head. He also united us to each other as living members of his Body, the Church. There is a profound union, a communion of holy things, among his holy people, his saints. We can pray and suffer for each other. We are united like the living parts of a body are united. My good is your good. Your good is my good. All Saints day reminds us that we are connected to all those in heaven. They too can help us. They too can share with us their secret for loving Christ. "I will spend my heaven teaching people to love Jesus as I do," St Therese once said.

The Oratory was meant by St Philip to remind people of the fundamental reality of the Church. The Oratory is a community of priests and brothers that live in one place. We are meant to show people that Christ established a community on earth founded on divine love. But what binds all as one Body? The Holy Spirit. The Holy Spirit poured out in his fullness at Pentecost established Christ's followers as a living Body. On this All Saints Day, let us cry out: *I believe in the Holy Spirit, living and acting in the Holy, Catholic Church.*

There will be a Solemn High Mass at 10am on **November 1**, at Holy Family Church, which is not only the date of the community's foundation in 1975, but coincides this year with the official declaration of the English Oratorian St John Henry Newman as a Doctor of the Church. A reception will follow in the Oratory itself, where you can come and see more of where and how we live. As all the Fathers and Brothers will be at this Mass, we are asking all our friends to attend this beautiful Latin Mass with us. **Join us as one family at the 10am Mass at the main Oratory church.**
