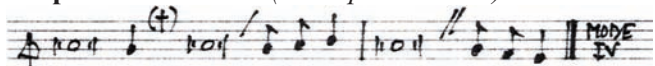

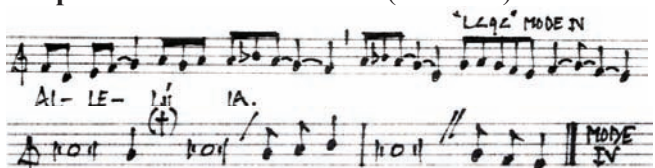

ORATORY CORNER

We thank all those who attended our 50th anniversary celebrations. Thank you for all those who volunteered for these events. We live as part of the Church. The newest doctor of the Church, St John Henry, wrote: "God has created me to do Him some definite service; He has committed some work to me which He has not committed to another. I have my mission—I never may know it in this life, but I shall be told it in the next. Somehow, I am necessary for His purposes, as necessary in my place as an Archangel in his—if, indeed, I fail, He can raise another, as He could make the stones children of Abraham. Yet I have a part in this great work; I am a link

in a chain, a bond of connexion between persons. He has not created me for naught. I shall do good, I shall do His work; I shall be an angel of peace, a preacher of truth in my own place, while not intending it, if I do but keep His commandments and serve Him in my calling."

The Church is the mystical Body of Christ. Each one of us is part of this great Body. We are ourselves in relation to the other members. This great truth of our place in the Church is illustrated by the recent feast of Sts Simon and Jude-Thaddeus, Apostles. In the four lists of the Apostles given in the New Testament, they are the only two who are *always listed* as next to each other in either 10th or 11th place.

Why is this connection so important? These Apostles teach us something about the Church in general and the Christian life as a whole. There are people in the Church that we are especially connected to. There are people in the Church we are called to work with in a personal way. We are in the service of each other. We, like Simon and Jude, have our identity in Christ and in relation to each other. But having our identity in relation to others is not strange. Even in God, the divine Persons have their identity in relation to each Other. The Father is the Father precisely in relation to the Son.

As we pray for the dead today, let us lift up our hearts. The Church is founded on the most Holy Trinity. The Church is a communion of persons that unites heaven and earth and purgatory. The joy of recent parish events and Oratory events is a foretaste of the glory in heaven.



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
