ORATORY CORNER

Last Saturday, the Oratorian, St John Henry Newman, was solemnly declared a doctor of the Church by Pope Leo XIV. A doctor of the Church is someone whose teaching is supposed to have special value for the universal Church. *What is of such great value in St John Henry's writings?*

One timely example is his teaching on purgatory. St John Henry Newman masterfully captures the moment of death and our particular judgment in his work, the [Dream of Gerontius](#). When the soul goes before Jesus after death, the soul sees his human face. His eyes of love and mercy cause two feelings in the soul: immense longing for him and shame of self. The soul is set on fire with a desire to be with God. At the same time, the soul is ashamed to its core of so often turning from him. The fire of purgatory is primarily this interior burning that also transforms. In the fifth part of this poem, the guardian Angel of Gerontius says:

*And these two pains, so counter and so keen, -
The longing for Him, when thou seest Him not;
The shame of self at thought of seeing Him, -
Will be they veriest, sharpest purgatory.*



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
