

ORATORY CORNER
St John Henry Newman is the first Oratorian to be declared a doctor of the Church. He is the first English speaker to be a doctor of the Church. The Lord has chosen this time for St John Henry's teachings to spread more widely. Last week, we looked at his teaching on the double pain of purgatory: longing for Jesus and shame at self.

But St John Henry Newman did not always

believe there was a purgatory. Newman was not raised as a Catholic. He became a Catholic in 1845. He was 44 years old. Born in 1801, Newman died on August 11, 1890. Half of his life was spent as an Anglican. Half his life was spent as a Catholic. His feast day, October 9, is not the day of his birth into eternity, but the day of his entering full communion with the Catholic Church.

When Bl. Dominic Barberi arrived at his home on October 8, Newman knelt down and asked to be received into the "one true fold of the Redeemer." Newman's conversion story is recounted in his famous, but difficult autobiography: *Apologia pro vita* sua. St John Henry, draw many to Christ's true fold!
