

ORATORY CORNER

St John Henry Newman not only introduced the Oratory into the English-speaking world, not only founded two Oratories (Birmingham and London), but he also can be considered the second Founder. No one can take St Philip Neri's place in the Oratorian life. His presence and friendship is integral to the vocation of an Oratorian. But St Philip's way of life requires men to carry it on.

St John Henry Newman appropriated the Oratorian life while living in Rome. He visited many Oratorian communities in Italy. He brought the living reality, transplanted that reality, to new soil. Newman was aware that living things remain themselves by growing and changing. In establishing the Oratory in England, Newman adapted it. England of the 19th century was not the same place as Rome of the 16th century. In Newman's writings on the essence of the Oratorian life, on the way he adapted it, we see a kind of second Founder. He showed how this life of St Philip can continue to live and thrive.

These ideas of change and continuity are part of St John Henry's larger message for the Church. In the book he was writing at the time of his conversion to Catholicism, Newman writes: "old principles reappear under new forms. It changes with them in order to remain the same. In a higher world it is otherwise, but here below to live is to change, and to be perfect is to have changed often" (*Essay on Development*, 41).
